A proposal has been received by this office from Executive Engineer Office, Construction Division (Building), **Public Work Department, Gorakhpur** for Widening and Strengthening of City Portion Ch. 0.00 to 3.250 of NH-29 Nausarh Chauraha to Baghagada in Gorakhpur District for Diversion under (Forest Conservation Act, 1980) of 4.225 Hect. Protected forest land for Non Forestry Purpose. The project envisages the use of Forest Land for Construction of Road.

The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has done by me on dated. 19/2/2018 On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a Protected Forest measuring **4.225 ha**.


