

 Unmetalled roads and cart-tracks in this sheet are generally motable in dry season. Permission to use those along canals is required from the Irrigation authorities.
 The areas adjoining the Yamuna River and Jai Nala are liable to change owing to continual fluctuation in the courses of the river and the nala.
