NOTES

Distance stones along canals and drains are 1000 feet apart and every existing fifth stone is shown
whereas along Bahadur Branch (SIRINDO CANAL) and Pakhowāli Distributary there are 5000 feet apart
and every existing one is shown.
Permission to use cart-tracks and unmetalled roads along canals is required from the Irrigation authorities.
Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.
Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
A relative height, in feet, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a
steep slope.
Most of the wells, in this area are generally disused.
