- b) The proposal for such diversion with full details of the project and its implication in vernacular/local language have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of Forestdwellers, who are eligible under the FRA;
- c) The each of concerned Gram Sabha(s) has certified that all formalities/processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, it any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the gram sabha of Sikandrabad Dehat Village is enclosed as annexure 01 to 05 annexure 05.
- d) The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken pace only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present.
- e) The Diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under sectin 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama Sabha have given their consent to it.

f) The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1) (e) of the FRA.
