### CA LAND SUITABILITY CERTIFICATE UNDER FCA 1980

[Cases where the proposed non-forest CA land can support the prescribed planting density of 1000 plants per hectare and it is necessary to plant the balance number of plants in degraded forest land (-40° canopy density) as per Working Plan prescription in accordance with Government of India FC Guidelines F.No.11-423/2011-FC dated : 08.11.2017].

In compliance of the procedure established for diversion of forestland for non-forest purpose through the Forest Conservation Rules 2003 and guidelines framed under the Forest Conservation Act 1980, the following is certified.

1. The non-forest land parcel(s) [Table-1] proposed by M/s. M Hanumantha Rao, Ballari for raising Compensatory Afforestation (CA) in forest land for Approach Road proposal number FP/KA/MIN/151513/2022 [FORM-A] - 6.835 ha and other proposal for diversion forestland in Ballari Division has been inspected by me on: 04<sup>th</sup> February, 2022.
1. Said non-forest CA land parcels measuring 28.59 Acres are suitable for raising compensatory afforestation in accordance with the Government of India FC Guidelines F. No. 11-423/2011-FC Dt 08-11-2017 read with general FC Guidelines, and in case of Private Party User Agency, further as per Government of Karnataka Order No. FEE 82 FLL 2016 dated 31-08-2016. However, it is proposed to take up Compensatory Afforestation works at an alternate site as afforestation at proposed CA Sites is not advisable for ecological reasons (GIB Conservation).
2. Proposed CA Land parcels forms part of the Great Indian Bustard landscape in Sirguppa Taluk of Ballari District. From point of conservation of GIBs, it is not advisable to create thick vegetation dominated by trees. Hence, afforestation works is proposed to be taken up in degraded forest land [Details in Table-2] in consonance with the Working Plan prescriptions.
3. The KML files, Topo Maps, Geo-referenced Maps & GPS readings of all corners of the proposed land parcels have to be uploaded by User Agency in PART-I of the proposal.
4. The KML files, Topo Maps, Geo-referenced Maps & GPS readings of all corners of the proposed degraded forest land are to be enclosed in PART-II of the proposal.
