## Site Inspection report of DCF

Date of Inspection : 16.06.2020

The site has been inspected in presence of the user-agency. The proposed retail outlet is on Sasaram-Chousa (SH-17) Road. Which is a PWD road and declared as protected forest vide govt. of Bihar notification no.189E/190E, dated 16.02.1994. The retail outlet is proposed to be established on Khata no.-132, Plot no.-1184,1185, Thana no.-249, Mouza-Sirsiya, Distt.-Rohtas on Personal land. There are no tree present on the site. As per the measurement made on the field the total land proposed to be required for entry and exit path of the fuel station is 0.01575 hac.

There is no rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna found in the proposed area. Neither any archaeological site is present near the proposed outlet.

The user agency has not done any work on the site in violation of the Forest Conservation Act, 1980.
