

## Site Inspection Report of Deputy Conservator of Forest Belgaum Division, Belgaum


On 02-10-2019, along with officials of Goa Tamnar Transmission Line Project, Assistant Conservator of Forest Nagargalli and Khanapur, Range Forest Officers Gollihalli, Nagargalli and Londa Range, I have inspected the Goa Tamnar Transmission Project – LILO of one ckt of Narendra (Existing) – Narendra (New) 400 kV D/C Quad Transmission Line.

During inspection it was observed that the above transmission line projects passes through Gollihalli, Nagargalli and Londa Ranges in Belgaum Division. The F.Sy No. details are as below:-

Thus the total area to be diverted for the proposed transmission line in Belgaum Division is 101.747 Ha. The land is marked by the Goa Tamnar Transmission Line Project and found fit for the purpose of diversion for the proposed Goa Tamnar Transmission Line 400kV.

Hence I recommend the diversion of above said forest area for the purpose of Goa Tamnar Transmission Line LILO of one ckt of Narendra(Existing) - Narendra(New) 400kV D/C Quad transmission Line project as per Forest (Conservation) Act – 1980.
