



Site inspection report of the DCF

The site has been inspected by me on19.03.2020..... The proposed retail outlet is on Khagaria-Bakhri road which is a PWD road and declared as protected forest vide govt. of Bihar notification no. 189E/190E dated 16.02.1994. The retail outlet is proposed to be established on khata no. 10 khesra no. 225, 229 village- Choti Kothia, P.s- Muffasil, Dist- Khagaria on lease land. There is one tree present on the site. As per the measurement made on the field the total land proposed to be required for entry & exit path of the fuel station is 1350 sq. mt. or 0.135 Ha. The measurement was done taking 5.5 mt. exit & entry path and 2.0 mt. flank each as per the direction of the CCF cum Nodal Officer (FC), Bihar, Patna issued vide his letter no. FC 106 dated 19.03.2013.

There is no rare/endangered/unique species of flora & fauna found in the area. Neither any archaeological site is present near the proposed outlet.

The user agency has not done any work on the site in violation of the F(C) Act, 1980. The width of entry & exit each would be 7.5 mt. including the flank. There is next petrol pump is situated is 03 K.M east & 05 K.M towards west respectively and addition to it there ~~are~~ one tree on the site. The user agency may be directed to carry out the work protecting that tree.
