Government of Gujarat Forest & Environment Department Gandhinagar vide its circular mentioned under reference no-1 has delegates power under General Approval to the concerned Division forest officer to grant approval under Forest (Conservation) Act 1980 for laying of underground optical fiber cable, Telephone lines, drinking water, electric line, CNG/PNG Pipeline along the roads within existing right of way not falling in National Park and Wildlife Sanctuary, without felling of trees, where the maximum size of trench is not more Than 2 mtr depth and 1 mtr width subject to certain conditions.

AND whereas, the user agency while applying and through the documents Submitted has Confirmed that its FCA proposal falls along the roads within existing Right of Way not Falling in National Park & Wildlife Sanctuary without felling of trees where the maximum Size of trench is not more than 2 Mtr depth and 1 Mtr width and hence fulfills all the above specified conditions & eligibility as laid down in circular mentioned as ref (1) and falls under the category of proposal eligible for "General Approval"

AND whereas having verified on the site that above facts are correct and fulfill the above Specific conditions of "General Approval" the following order is issued.

In view of the above the undersigned is pleased to convey its "in-principle" approval for Diversion of 1.02564 Ha of Protected Forest subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. This permission is granted only for the use of the forest land for the purpose specified in the proposal. The legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
- 2. The cost of NPV and CA is Exempted as per the Reference No (3) and as per the ref No (4) for the National Optical Fiber Network (NOFN) Project and Bharat Broadband Network Limited project Registration Fees, Processing Fees is Exempted.
- 3. The User Agency shall generate challan through OSFMWC portal before making payment for Stage-II clearance process. All the fund shall be deposited through OSMFWC portal by the User Agency.
- 4. In future if any amount regarding net present value (NPV) or compensatory afforestation (CA) is required, the user agency is bounded to pay in favour of Deputy Conservator of Forest.
- 5. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the FCA proposal.
- 6. The user agency will have to obtain permission from the undersigned for carrying out any maintenance works in future
- 7. The user agency will have to make good the forest land after use / maintenance works. No tree shall be cut.
- 8. The user agency will be liable to make good any loss to Forests/ Environment cause due to use of the said land by the user agency.
- 9. The user agency will seek permission from Road & Building Department /Science and Technology Department. Sachivalay Gandhinagar if required so.
- 10. The line will be laid underground in a trench of the depth 2.00 mtr & width 1.00 mtr in between rows of road side plantation with no damage to either plantation or barbed wire fencing and by employing manual labor wherever necessary.
- 11. The User Agency shall submit the detail regarding compliance of MoEF's guidelines dated 03.08.2009 & 05.02.2013 with regard to the schedule tribes & other forest Dwellers (Recognisation of Forest Rights) Act.,-2006
- 12. The additional condition under chapter 5 of Forest (Conservation) Act- 1980 shall be applicable to this proposal as the Government of Gujarat resolutions no. FCA-1013/11-10/11 /SF-24, dated 12.06.2015. The user agency shall comply additional condition as per the aforementioned resolutions.
- 13. Any other condition, with the Nodal Officer (FCA)/ the State Government may stipulate from time to time.

After receipt of compliance report on the fulfillment of conditions no (2),(3),(5) & (12) mentioned above from you, order of formal approval will be issued by this Department.
