### SITE INSPECTION REPORT

Certified that I have inspected the proposed forest land to be diverted in Kabeerabad, Byalahalli and Anadoor villages of Humnabad, Bhalki and Bidar Taluks of Bidar District respectively for Laying of 203mm,152mm,101mm diameter steel Gas pipeline, from Reliance Gas Transportation Infrastructure Limited terminal CS-05 at Jalsingi along NH-50, within road RoW to Bidar with forest diversion in favour of Bharat Gas Resources Limited on 17.12.2021. The total forest area required for the project is 0.602 ha. The proposed gas pipeline is laid along the existing RoW in the already diverted forest area for Upgradation of NH-50 vide proposal No FP/KA/ROAD/33965/2018. There are no trees required to be felled for this project.

There is no endangered fauna in the said area, no protected, Archeological, Heritage / Site / Defence Establishment or any other important monument area located in the forest area to be diverted.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by user agency (0.602 ha.) is the bare minimum for the project and there is no suitable non-forest land available for executing the said project.

There is no violation of Forest Conservation Act 1980, in the proposed area.
