Diversion of forest land for underground OFC duct and cable within ROW of existing road (ODR 61) from Talashi, Tal. Radhanagri, to Savarde Bk. Tal. Kagal, Dist. Kolhapur. Road passing through forest land at Kasaba Walve, Tal. - Radhanagri, Dist. – Kolhapur. Road passing through forest land at village- Kasaba Walve, Tal. Radhanagri. The Row of existing road selected as the maximum area will be covered for mobile network and easy maintain for long period.

Project Authority has not started work in forest land and in non-Forest land. P. A. will start work after sanction by State Govt.

There is no alternative non-forest land available. The proposal is site specific. The area is to be diverted is not sensitive and hence will not have any adverse effect on the ecology of area. Hence this proposal is recommended for

diversion of the forest land for laying of underground OFC Cable within Row of existing Road Passing through forest at village- Kasaba Walve Tal- Radhanagari, Dist. -Kolhapur.
