SITE INSPECTION REPORT OF CHIEF CONSERVATOR OF FORESTS, MEDAK CIRCLE ON 14.09.2021

Proceeded to Narayankhed Range in Sangareddy District and inspected the proposed diversion areas of Reserved Forests towards Imporvement and widening to two lane with paved shoulder from 0.0 to km to 49.0 km of NH-161 B on Nizamabad – Narayankhed – Bidar Road route through RFs Railamadugu, Nemalimet and Jhukkal Kurd.

The first stretch of road diversion falls in Railamadugu RF in Compt.No.417 to the length of 2182 mt. with 30 mt. width and 230 mt. with 40 mt. width. The width of existing road is 7.00 mtr. The trees which are proposed for extraction along both sides of existing road are numbered serially. The species like Chennangi (<u>Lagerstroemia Sp</u>), Moduga (<u>Butea Sp</u>) Rela (<u>Cassia fistula</u>), Vepa (<u>Azadirachta indica</u>) and few Teak are enumerated.

Further inspected 2^{nd} stretch in Compt.No.418 of Nemalimet RF, where the proposed length is 548 mt. with 30 mt. width and 230 mt. with 40 mt, totaling an area of 2.5643 Ha falling under RF.

Further inspected the last stretch i.e. Compt.No.420 of Jhukkal Kurd RF, where an area of 5.562 Ha is proposed for diversion. (1548 mt. length with 30 mt. wide of 230 mt. with 40 mt. wide), hence the total area of diversion in RF comes around 15.592 Ha with 2354 Nos of trees enumerated and proposed for extraction at the time of road improvement and widening.



There are few measures proposed at the time of Road widening and are listed as

 The User Agency shall propose extraction of trees which are unavoidable for road widening and shall be kept at bare minimum.

follows:

- ii) The User Agency shall fix proper signages at important locations and curves to reduce the speed and to facilitate the movement of Wildlife.
- iii) The User Agency shall construct under passages at few places to facilitate free movement of Wildlife.
- iv) The User Agency shall not cause damage to the flora and fauna located adjoining proposed project area.
