As per letter number 2-2/2000 FC darted 16.10.2000 from ministry of Environment & Forest, Government of india for proposal involving less then 40 hectares of forest land, the site injection report from DCF is required. And for proposal involving more the 40 hectares of forest land site inspection report from the conservator of forests is required.

The site inspection of the road was conducted by the under signed on 28th December 2018. The main observations are as follows:-

- 1. There are five muck dumping sites along the entire stretch of 4.875 km. road. The muck disposal plan prepared by user agency lack proper design and estimation as per the requirement of the site. The user agency has not taken into consideration the slope factor at respective sites and has arbitrarily manipulated the volume of the sites as per the volume of the muck. A proper muck disposal plan as per the requirement of the site with proper design & estimation shall be reproduced and annexed with the proposal by the user agency.
- 2. The user agency has not taken into consideration the trees likely to be affected in the muck dumping area. The user agency shall include the above stated trees in the overall list of the trees likely to be affected/felled.
- 3. The alignment has not been marked with Level pillars & Cutting pillars which poses a difficulty to identified the alignment in the field. The user agency is required to construct the above stated pillars after every 25 meters distance along the entire alignment.
- 4. The area is the habitated with important wild life species like Leopard, Black Bear, Gural, Kakad etc. The road may not affect them directly but may affect their movement which needs to be compensated by proposing wild life management plan. A wild life management plan should be included in the proposal shall be funded by the user agency.
- 5. Three important streams namely Surdegi nala, Paniyara khala & Molti nala are likely to be affected by road cutting. As elaborated by the geologist report proper watershed treatment shall be carried out in the above streams so as to protect their catchment. A proposal of the same shall be included in the land transfer proposal.
- 6. A forest guard chowki is likely to be demolished in the present alignment.

 Compensation shall be provided by the user agency.
