Observations made by the Chief Conservator of Forests Kalaburagi Circle, Kalaburagi on Inspection of Sy. No. 85, Arakera Hobli, Devdurga Taluk, Alkod Village of Raichur District (Karnataka) on 14-07-2020.

- 1) The area required for the project is 0.86 Ha. in proposed area in Sy. No. 85, Alkod Village.
- 2) The proposed forest land to be diverted is RF. The Alkod RF declared as Section-17 of Karnataka Forest Act 1963 and Notified vide Notification No. ಅಪಜೀ 102 ಎಫ್‌ಎಫ್ 2014 Dated: 10-11-2014.

There is no endangered fauna in the said area, no protected, Archeological Heritage/Site/Defense Establishment or any other important monuments area located in the area.
