RECOMMENDATION REPORT

I have inspected the proposed site for diversion for establishment of Kuvempu University in wildlife area of Singanamane Minor Forest in the following villages of Lakkavalli Wildlife Range, Bhadra Tiger Reserve on Date: 21-05-2021.

In compliance with the condition of the Indian Board of Wildlife, the proposed area of diversion is recommended to be reduced to 89.92 ha. (222.08 acres) for approval under Forest (Conservation) Act 1980. The area to an extent of 12 Guntas is recommended to be reduce in Byrapura Village Sy. No- 37 as this Survey Number has some portion of undisturbed forest area on the fringe of it and adjoining to the Bhadra Tiger Reserve. The details of the forest area recommended for diversion is listed as below.
