

INSPECTION REPORT


The undersigned inspected the site on 05-10-2019 along with the Assistant Conservator of Forests, Sub-division, Ganeshgudi and Range Forest Officer Tinaighat. The proposed site along with Castlerock – Carzon Railway line at Devalli village F.S. No.04/A1/A1/A1/A1/A1, Devalli Survey No. 10A, Devalli Survey No. 04, Devalli Survey No. 10B, Konsheth Survey No. 7/1A of Tinaighat Range of Joida Taluk in Haliyal Forest Division. The site is located in Reserve Forest besides the Alnavar to Tinaighat Railway Line, 74 kms away from Haliyal Town.

The proposed land is not a part of National Park, Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant corridor etc. There are no archaeologically important monuments and defence sites located in the proposed land. The legal status of forest land remained as Reserve Forest and the user agency is ready to pay Compensatory Afforestation charges, Penal Compensatory afforestation charges, Net Present Value, Lease rent etc. as fixed by the Government. User agency planned for Castlerock – Carzon Railway line doubling, thus there is no any damage to Reserve Forest.

It is found that there is no rare/endangered unique species and archaeological/heritage site in said Forest area. Total 181 trees to be felling is required. The requirement of the forest land as proposed by the user agency is unavoidable and barest minimum for the project.
