13)	Specific recommendations of the DCF for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal with reasons.		<p>Recommended because it is the only area available as the rest of the area is densely vegetated and would involve felling of trees which is not the case is the proposed land area.</p> <p>The Following conditions may be imposed :-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) The tractor (for transporting only essential Food material) may be allowed only once in every fifteen days (fortnight) through out the year. and on the occasion of "Urs" , "Patelbapu Janmatithi", "Maha Shivratri mela" & Parikrama it may be allowed in the said week. (2) The vehicles movement time will be restricted from sunrise to sunset to minimize disturbance to the wildlife. (3) Every time before transporting the material from Wellington Dam Road to (by the side of the stair) to Sakkarmai place on Datar hill, the Forest dept. should be informed in advance. (4) Tractors should adhere to all pollution control norms in existence at the time. (5) Tractors should only transport essential Food material upto the Sakkarmai place on Datar hill for maintenance of trust as mentioned in proposal. (6) No building material or any other material except essential food material will be transported through this route. No passengers to be transported by this road. (7) In case of Forest Fire or any other

requirement by forest department in the interest of forest protection and conservation the department the department may use this facility.

- (8) Precaution is to be kept while using the said road, so that no damage to wildlife or adjoining forest areas is done.
- (9) To avoid misuse or unnecessary disturbance in the Wildlife Sanctuary, the construction of metal road is suggested, no cement concrete or tar road will be done in future.
- (10) The legal status of the proposed Land will be remain unchanged. It will continue to remain Sanctuary land.
- (11) For repairing the road, once in a year, the material may be brought from outside sanctuary area by informing the Department well in advance.
- (12) No vehicle, other than the designated tractor (number 1) of the agency will be allowed for transport. Use of the said road by two wheel and four wheel vehicle will be strictly prohibited.
- (13) Except the area of diversion i.e. 3243.00 meter (Length) 3.048 meter (width) total ha. 00.9885 area for road, no other additional land will be used for expansion or any other purpose.
- (14) In case of violation of any of the above conditions, the department will take strict action as per law.
- (15) The agency and or contractor will strictly follow provisions under the wildlife (protection) Act-1972
