**SITE INSPECTION REPORT**

Proposal Name: Diversion of 0.8477 Hectare of Forest Land for Filling of 16 Tanks for Drinking Purpose in Bheemanakere & Hallikere Villages, Kasaba Hobli, Maddur Taluk, Mandya District.

Proposal No. FP/KA/IRRIG/47109/2020

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Site inspection have been done at the proposed project area on 31-01-2023 and 17-02-2023 along with the Range Forest Officers – Maddur range, Assistant Conservator of Forests, Mandya Sub-division, and other jurisdictional officers and representatives of the CNNL VC Division Mandya project team. The project requiring land diversion is a distribution pipeline component for the filling of 16 Tanks for Drinking Purpose project. It is a Linear project and the proposed forest land for diversion falls in Byadarahalli village survey No. 21, Bheemanakere village survey No. 120 and Hallikere survey No. 92. The identified land parcels for diversion were C & D class land transferred from Revenue Department to Forest Department and now figuring in the list of deemed forest land.

The project requires 0.8477 ha of forest land to be diverted. The project area mainly comprises of hillock foothill and plains with moderate tree growth. The vegetation is mainly eucalyptus interspersed with other local species. Enumeration of tree numbers, girth and height along with the species, falling within the proposed project area were done and reported by the RFO and the ACF and details are uploaded in Part 2 of the form. No rare and endangered unique species of flora and fauna is found in the proposed area. Nearest point in the proposed area is approximately 3.5 KM from Kokkare Bellur Community Reserve. The project proposed area does not fall in areas of any monument of historical, recreational or archaeological importance including National Parks and Wildlife Sanctuary. The forest land proposed for diversion is bare minimum and is essential for the providing basic water facilities the public
