
**Inspection note, finding and recommendations with reasons**

The proposed site was inspected on 13.07.2018. The factual details regarding the Proposed site and consequent findings are Stated below:-

1. The Proposal site is situated on Muzaffarpur-Pusa-Samastipur road. The Proposed area is a part of protected Forest vide Government of Bihar Notification No-189E/190E dated 16.02.1994. The forest land required in order to establish outlet is 0.02212 Ha. as per map attached with this Proposal.
2. The user agency Proposed for diversion of 0.02212 Ha. of forest land in order to use for entry & exist of the vehicles from retails outlet.
3. There is no tree present on the site. There are no rare/endangered/unique species of flora & fauna found in the area. No archaeological site is present in and around the proposed outlet.
4. The user agency has not done any work on the site.

On the basis of the recommendation of the Deputy Conservator of Forests and the inspection made by me, the proposal may be accepted due to fallowing reasons :-

1. The density of the road side Protected Forest is very low. The acceptance of the proposal, as it entails provision of compensatory afforestation along the road side, as is costumany, may help to increase forest density & green cover.
2. The forest area involved in this project is only 0.02212 Ha, which is bare minimum & is quite low.
