


Site Inspection Report of Chief Conservator of Forests, Central Circle, Thrissur
for the Proposal No. FP/KL/ROAD/151269/2022

The proposed site was inspected with Divisional Forest Officer, Thrissur on 22.03.2022. The user agency has requested 0.0254 ha. forest land for the Black Spot Rectification work at Vazhakodu curve km-68/805 of Kodungallur-Shornur State Highway-22. The requested area comes in an isolated rectangular plot having an extent of 0.0276 ha, situated in Mullurkkara Village sy no. 480/14, Thalappilly Thaluk, Thrissur District. As per BTR this bit of land is marked as Government puramboke (Forest station). This piece of land is protected with cairns and lies 300 metres away from the nearest Reserve Forest, Bharanipacha mala. During the inspection of the site, it was noticed that there are 5 trees- *Samania saman* (GBH-300m), *Artocarpus hetrophyllus* (GBH-166 cm), *Mangifera indica* (GBH-150 cm) *Tectona grandis* (GBH-150cm), *Azadirachata indica* (GBH-90 cm) -have to be felled for the execution of the project. No other endangered /unique species of flora and fauna were found in the proposed area. The area proposed by the user agency is bare minimum and unavoidable for the project. Hence it is recommended for favourable consideration under Forest (conservation) Act, 1980.
