The proposed bypass is very useful for the benefit of a Large population residing in and around Gumla and facilitate the movement of vehicle moving on N.H.</p> <p>It is hereby recommended that proposed notified forest land of 0.44 ha. and 7.21 ha. Jungle-jhari land (Total 7.65 ha.) of Gumla Division, Gumla may be diverted for construction of proposed bypass. As per report submitted by D.F.O. Gumla, the distance of proposed road from boundary of Palkot wild life sanctuary is approx 3.5 K M. which comes under Eco Sensitive Zone (E.S.Z) of Palkot wild life sanctuary. By this project there is less probability of being affected the wild life of sanctuary.</p> <p>The user agency should give C.A. land and requisite amount for C.A. in lieu of forest land which will be diverted as per proposal for construction of bypass.</p>
