## SITE INSPECTION REPORT

The proposed project area has been inspected by me along with Range Forest Officer, Hassan, Asst. Conservator of Forests & TA to DCF, Hassan and Officers and Staff of KUWS & DB, Hassan Division on 6<sup>th</sup> of August, 2018 (Kattaya Kaval Sy. No. 126, 129, 142, 143 & 145. The proposed project area falls in Kattaya village of Hassan Taluk under Hassan Range of Hassan Division.

Even-though, the project area involves minimum area but the forest area required is only 0.9894 ha. The details of Sy. No. and Village-wise forest area required is as follows:
