## Diversion of 0.035 ha. Mangrove Forest land (Unclassified) for providing and laying of main sewer line 1400 mm dia from Juinagar to Sanpada STP in Navi Mumbai at Village-Sonkhar, The & Distt-Thane

Specific Recommendation of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests,
Maharashtra State (Head of Forest Force) with regards to acceptance or
otherwise of the proposal supported by reasons.

The proposal for diversion of 0.035ha Mangrove Forest land (Unclassified) for providing and laying of main sewer line 1400 mm dia from Juinagar to Sanpada STP in Navi Mumbai has been initiated by Executive Engineer Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation , Mumbai. Total area covered under the project is 0.055 ha. out of which 0.020 ha. is non forest land and 0.035 ha is Mangrove Forest land. The details of forest land proposed for diversion is as under .-

- 2.1 The user agency has highlighted that, The Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation (NMMC) has prepared underground sewerage DPR for NMMC area which was subsequently approved under JnNURM scheme of Urban Development department of Govt of India. In approved DPR, it is proposed that part of sewerage generation from Nerul Node shall be treated in Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) located at Sanpada Sec-20. Hence Terminal sewage line of 1400 mm dia is proposed to connect to Sanpada STP which is passing through mangroves area located near creek.
- 2.2 The said project is very vital for NMMC to provide good sanitation and hygiene conditions to the peoples/residents who are living the entire area. The proposed sewer line carries the partial sewerage load of Nerul and Sanpada node to STP at Sector -20 Sanpada. Because of absence of connection of proposed line to the STP, STP is not functioning on full load capacity. The STP is based on modern technology. Hence it is therefore eminently necessary to start the STP plant at Sanpada on full load capacity. The total length of proposed work is 110.00 meter, out of this 70.00 meter line is passing through mangroves area. The estimated cost of the project is Rs. 154 lakh. Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation (NMMC) approved the project.

Compensatory Afforestation will be raised at the cost of user agency over 1.00 ha 6.4 degraded forest land of Survey No 263 CTS: 2(p) at Village-Malvani, The-Borivali, District-Mumbai Suburban. As per GOI guidelines dated 08/11/2017 at least 1000 plants per ha. to be planted on non forest land identified for compensatory afforestation. The boundary of the diverted forest land, shall be demarcated on ground at the 6.5 project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars., each inscribed with its serial number, forward and back bearing and distance from pillar to pillar The user agency will obtain Environmental Clearance from competent authority, if 6.6 required. The user agency shall obtain CRZ Clearance from competent authority. 6.7 Permission of Hon'ble High Court, Bombay shall be obtained for implementing the 6.8 project in mangrove areas as per Bombay High Court order dated 27/01/2010 in PIL No. 87/2006. The User agency should strictly adhere to the conditions mentioned in Hon'ble High Court, Bombay order dated 04/02/2016 in PIL 87/2006.
  - As the project area falls within the deemed Eco Sensitive Zone of the proposed Thane Creek Flamingo sanctuary, the user agency shall meet the cost for implementation of Conservation plan, approved by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Wildlife) & CWLW.

- 6.10 Construction of temporary dwelling / hutments etc. for labours will not be allowed in the forest areas.
- 6.11 No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused;
- The user agency will defray the cost of removal of 15 trees in the area. However, only the required and minimum number of trees will be felled. In situations where felling of trees is avoidable and such trees could be transplanted, all efforts to transplant such trees at a pre designated site will be taken and additional expenditure, if any, in such cases shall be at the cost of the user agency.
- No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- 6.14 All other conditions as may be mandatory under relevant Acts, Rules and guidelines shall be complied with by the user agency.

- Permission of Hon'ble High Court, Bombay shall be obtained for implementing the project in mangrove areas as per Bombay High Court order dated 27/01/2010 in PIL No. 87/2006. The User agency should strictly adhere to the conditions mentioned in Hon'ble High Court, Bombay order dated 04/02/2016 in PIL 87/2006.
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- 6.13 No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- 6.14 All other conditions as may be mandatory under relevant Acts, Rules and guidelines shall be complied with by the user agency.

It is therefore requested that the Central Government may kindly be moved to approve diversion of 0.035 ha. Forest Land in favour of Executive Engineer Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation , Mumbai for providing and laying of main sewer line 1400 mm dia from Juinagar to Sanpada STP in Navi Mumbai at Vill-Sonkhar, Tahsil & Distt-Thane in the State of Maharashtra under section (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act 1980.
