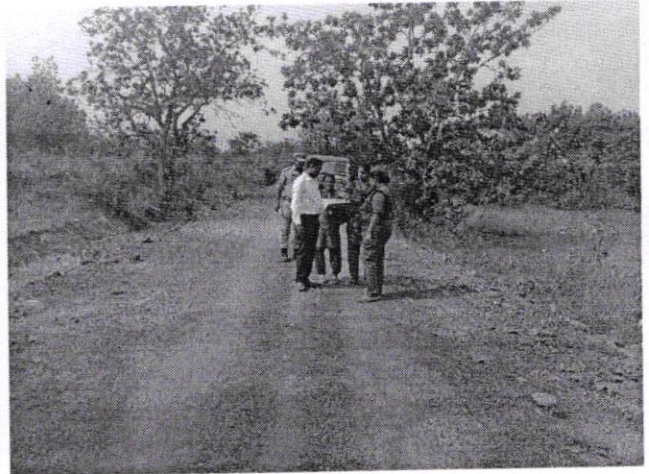
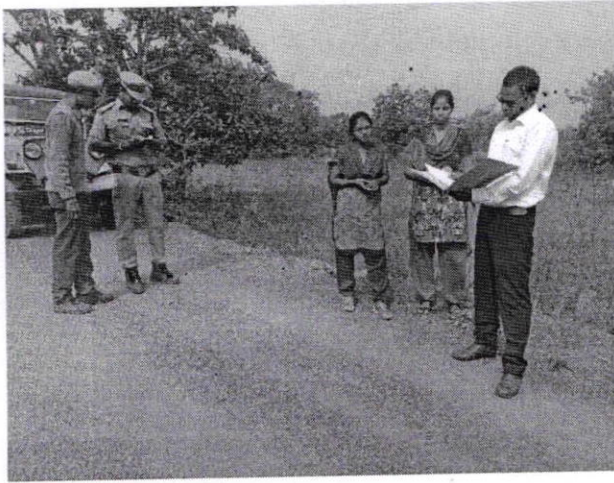


**Field Inspection report of the Divisional Forest Officer, Chintur on 12-11-2018**  
**Regarding Diversion of forestland 3.28 Ha. for formation & BT to the road including**  
**construction of culverts from ZP Road at Kothapally to Nelakota village falling in**  
**Vemulrai and Vemulrai Extn-I R.Fs., Lakkavaram Range of Chintur Division in**  
**favour of Executive Engineer(PR),PIU Division, Kakinada**

On 12-11-2018 inspected the proposed forest land for formation & BT to the road including construction of culverts from ZP Road at Kothapally to Nelakota village which is passing through Compartment No.12, Vemularai R.F., & Compt.No.191, Vemularai Extn.-I Reserve Forest of Lakkavaram Range. The concerned Panchayath Raj staff and Forest Range Officer, Lakkavaram along with her staff accompanied in the field inspection. The proposed Road length is 6000 Mtrs. and width of 6.00 Mtrs.

The proposed Road was already existing as gravel road and used by the local villagers long back for passing small vehicles for their day to day movements. There is no tree felling involved along the length and width of proposed road and the proposed area falls under the Eco-class III with Eco-value of Dense Forest and the density of the forests on the proposed width of the road is less than 0.10 density. The details of existing flora in the proposed area for diversion and the adjacent area are Dalberfia latifolia, Choloroxylon switenia, Albizzia odoratissima, Anogeissus latifolia, Diaspyros melanoxylon, Lannea grandis, Madhuca indica.



This project is very useful for the local villagers to connect mandal Head Quarters. The required forest area is unavoidable for the project and due to this project there is no threat to the local flora, fauna and the proposed Forest areas does not fall in any wildlife sanctuary/ National Park/ Eco Sensitive Zone. There are no archeological sites of importance and no historical monuments. In the inspected area the User agency did not carry out any work in violation of the provisions of FC Act and other relevant acts.
