FIELD INSPECTION NOTES OF FOREST DIVISIONAL OFFICER, SHAMSHABAD DIVISION IN MUDIMYAL RESERVE FOREST ON 10.08.2021

I have inspected the proposed area for Diversion of 0.2038 Ha of Forest Land in Mudimyal Reserve Forest of Shamshabad Division of Rangareddy District of Rangareddy Circle for formation of approach to reach agricultural lands from Hyderabad -Vikrabad - Tandur - State Highway in favour of Sri. G. Chandrashekhar Reddy and others in Mudimyal RF along with Forest Range Officer, Chilkur and staff of Chilkur Range.

The proposed forest land situated in the Compt. Nos.197 in Mudimyal RF of Chilkur Range of Shamshabad Division in Ranga Reddy District. The total length of proposed road is 203.78 mtrs. with a width of 10.00 mtrs is passing through RF Mudimyal and the total area comes to 0.2038 Ha. Further, it is observed that, there are (2) alternatives roads are available to reach the agricultural lands which are to be runs along the RF boundary of mudimyal RF.

- From Mudimyal village road and along North-East side of the boundary of RF is comes to a length of 2.95 Kms.
- 2. From Malkaram village and along the boundary North-West side of the boundary of RF is comes to a length of 3.52 Km.

The proposed diversion of road is passing through middle of the Mudimyal RF block and it divides the block in (2) parts and there is no trees are existing in the proposed area. Further, it is observed that already this block was divided into (2) parts as the land was diverted for formation of Hyderabad - Vikarabad - Tandur State Highway, with this diversion from the one part of earlier diversion will divides into (2) parts. During enquiry with the staff the fauna presents in the area consists of mostly Wild Bores of Schedule (III) animals of Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972, which are not endangered.
