		sanctuary. Wildlife Conservation Measures as proposed by DCF may be	
		implemented by the User agency.	
		Deputy Conservator of Forests, Haveri Division has made an	
		observation that User agency need additional area of 0.1827 Ha. for	
		completion of road work and separate proposal need to be submitted for	
		the diversion of additional area of 0.1827 Ha.	
		Since the project is linear in nature and is upgradation of already	
		existing road and also of public utility nature. No protected	
		archeological/heritage site/defense establishment or any other important	
		monuments are located in the proposed area. There is no violation of	
		Forest Conservation Act, 1980, in the proposed area. Hence the area	
		may be recommended for diversion with the precautions to be levied on	
		User agency as per the recommendations of concerned DCF's.
