

SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF

(For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by this office from Executive Engineer, PMGSY-Division, P.W.D., Sonbhadra (U.P.) for diversion (under FCA-1980) of 8.01 ha forest land for Widening & Strengthening of Rampur-Barkoniya to Laua via Maukala Road from Km 0.00 To 20.200.

The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 19/01/2019

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a Reserve Forest measuring- 8.01 hac.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in Col. 2 of part-I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
