13. Specific recommendations of the DCF for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal with reasons. :
The proposed widening and strengthening of the road is a necessity in the light of the heavy movement of goods & public vehicles on this road. The Rajauli (Nawada) wildlife sanctuary is contiguous with Koderma Wildlife Sanctuary in Jharkhand State. The present road is bifurcating the Sanctuary in parts which is highly undesirable for wildlife habitat and objectionable also from management view point. Since the road is passing through Koderma Wildlife Sanctuary, discussion with D.F.O. Hazaribag Wildlife Division is made. The Hazaribag Wildlife Division has proposed & suggested for entire length of the road passing through their side to be constructed as flyover on piers. The fact is that the Rajauli (Nawada) Wildlife sanctuary was a part of Koderma Wildlife Sanctuary before bifurcation of the state. So it will be desirable to have same treatment for

the entire stretch of road passing through the sanctuary area. This will be beneficial for wildlife of both sanctuaries. So it is recommended to strengthen & widen the entire stretch of road passing through Rajauli (Nawada) Wildlife Sanctuary to be constructed on flyover. Further the user agency should deposit 5% of the project cost as special fund for preparation & implementation of schemes for the development of sanctuary area as a whole and wildlife in particular.
