

SITE INSPECTION REPORT OF D.C.F HAZARIABG EAST DIVISION, HAZARIBAG

A total of 12.7184 Ha. (P.F.- 3.587 Ha, GM Jungle Jhari - 9.1314 Ha) is proposed for diversion in Hazaribag East Forest Division consisting of 11 villages. The Protected Forest include Budha Chanch, Sonturpi, Bagodar, Hesla, Tirla, Taranari, Pokharia, Atka, Pochari, Gainra & Barai forest in Bagodar forest Range. The inspection was done on 03.01.2019. The vegetation in majority of the P.Fs mentioned above is dense, hence the density is 0.8.
