

Site Inspection Report of DCF


Date of Inspection: 01.07.2021

Name of project: Yadunathpur to Jaradag Jio Digital Fibre

The site has been inspected in presence of the representative of user-agency. The proposed underground fiber line is along the 12 km stretch of Forest Road passing through Protected Forest declared vide govt. of Bihar notification no. O/F-17036/56-1873.R dated 06.09.1956. These Protected Forests have also been declared as part of Kaimur Wildlife Sanctuary vide govt. of Bihar notification no. S.O. 1160 dated 25.07.1979. There are no trees falling in the forest area proposed for diversion. As per the measurement made on the field, the total land proposed to be required for the linear underground cable is 0.09864 hac.

The major faunal species found in the area are Leopard, Sloth bear and other common species of Kaimur Wildlife Sanctuary. However, due to the fiber optic cable being underground, no disturbance is expected to be caused to the flora and fauna in the area. Neither any archaeological site is present near the proposed outlet.

The user agency has not done any work on the site in violation of the Forest Conservation Act, 1980.
