I submit herewith, the details called in the reference 1st cited regarding proposal for diversion 0.133 Ha of Reserved Forest land in Konasamuthiram Reserved Forest for construction of road in the existing cart track mud road right of way to Cherlopalli in Pallipattu Taluk in Tiruvallur district as follows.


Recommendation of District Forest Officer, Tiruvallur

The Block Development Officer, Pallipattu Panchayat Union, Tiruvallur District submitted a proposal for the diversion of 0.133 Ha of Forest on Konasamudram Reserved Forest for the formation of road in the existing cart track to Cherlopalli village in Pallipattu Taluk, Tiruvallur District. The proposed site was inspected on 04.08.2022 along with Panchayat Officials and Forest staff.

The proposed area of diversion is (414.20m X 3.20m) 0.133 Ha. The proposed area of diversion is a right of way on the western boundary of the reserved forest connecting Cherolopalli village with the junction point at Athimanjeripet to Pothaturpet. The proposed diversion is the bare minimum and highly essential for the local people. The diversion does not involve any tree felling.

The diversion of 1330 m² (0.133 Ha) of forest land in Konasamudram Reserved Forest, Pallipattu Range, Tiruvallur Forest Division is recommended subject to the fulfilment of planting and maintenance of avenue trees all along the length of the proposed road as a demarcation and to prevent further biotic interference at the cost of the user agency.


