Site inspection report

The Block Development Officer, Pallipattu Panchayat Union, Tiruvallur District submitted a proposal for the diversion of 0.3003 Ha of Forest on Kodivalasa Reserved Forest for the formation of road in the existing mud road leading to UdayMuruganKoil, Nellikundrammalai in Pallipattu Taluk, Tiruvallur District.

The Kodivalasa Reserved Forest was declared as a Reserved Forest with an extent of 58.90 Ha vide G.O (Ms) No. 20, Environment & Forests (FR-14), dated 02.02.2007 under Pallipattu Range, Tiruvallur Forest Division.

The proposed forest diversion in the Right of Way admitted as Right 6 admitted to the public to use leading to UdayMuruganKoil. The mud road is 500.6m length and 6.0m width. The forest type is 'Southern dry mixed deciduous Forest' with a canopy density of 20-25%. Wild animals such as wild pig, porcupine, snakes, hares and jackals etc are found in the forest area.

The proposed area of diversion is (500.6m X 6.0m) 0.3003 Ha. The proposed area of diversion is a right of to the public to use leading to Uday Murugan Koil.
