

## SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF

A proposal has been received by the this office from Bharat Petroleum Corporation Ltd. Meerut for Nahatour-Noorpur-Amroha-Joya Road (S.H. No.77) Km. 53 (Ch. 52.421) for Construction of Entry/Exit, to Petrol/Diesel Pump Section for under (FCA-1980) on 0.037025 hac. of forest land ( non-forestry use) and No removal of Trees. The projects envisage the use of protected forest land for construction approach to Retail Outlet. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 24/2/2021

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a RF/PF/unclassified/Protect forest measuring. PF 0.037025 Hac.
