

SITE INSPECTION REPORT IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROPOSAL FOR DIVERSION OF OF 0.0378 Ha. FOREST LAND AT PADMAJA NAIDU HIMALAYAN ZOOLOGICAL PARK DARJEELING FOR CONSTRUCTION OF WATER RESERVOIR BY DARJEELING MUNICIPLITY UNDER AMRUT PROJECT.

The undersigned visited the proposed land diversion site on 22.06.2022. Darjeeling Municipality has proposed the land diversion proposal over 0.0378 Ha. comprising of two different plots viz. Plot no. 1 and 2 having extent of area 0.0189 Ha. each, for the construction of two number of water reservoir under AMRUT Project.

The proposed site is within the jurisdiction of forest area of Padmaza Naidu Himalayan Zoological Park ,Darjeeling.

The proposed site does not comes under the wildlife habitat zone and there has been no encroachment issue on it.

The site is free from any defence installations and structures of archaeological importance.

Involvement of one number of tree felling (Lek Chilune) during the execution of work, has been reported. The user agency is required to adopt all possible measures to avert any adversity to the area, outside the purview of the proposed site.
