A Proposal has been received by this office from Indian Oil Adani Gas pvt Ltd. Bulandshahr for diversion under (FCA-1980) of 0.45 ha. of protected forest land for non-forestry purpose. The Project envisage the use of forest land for laying Gas Pipe line at Delhi-Kanpur Road N H-91 (NEW NH-34) KM 61 Part to Km 70 Part on the Left hand side total 9.00 km. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 23-3-2021

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a Protected forest measuring 0.45 ha.
