

Site Inspection Report of the Divisional Forest Officer, North Wayanad Division

Proposal No. FP/KL/OFC/153556/2022


I have personally inspected the site on 23.05.2022 along with the Range Forest Officer, Begur . The proposed cable line to be passed along the main road from Irumpupalam to Begur Section Boundary and Pulivalmoola to to Appappara. It is going through Sy. No. 223,335 of Thirunelly village. Total length of Cable trench is 4.45 KM and total forest area to be diverted in North wayanad division is 0. 1338 Ha. The cable trench will be closed after laying the optical fiber cable and there will be no visible change in the nature of land as per the details by the user agency. Further it is stated that it is a critical infrastructure project which will greatly enhance the telecom connectivity and benefit the local tribal community. Thus the project is highly essential and there is no alternative route available. There is no need for cutting any tree for this project. Hence, i am recommending the project with the following conditions.

1. The trench should be closed properly after laying cable to avoid any casualty to wild animals.
2. FTTH and last mile connectivity to be provided as pro bono to all the Forest offices and tribal colonies under this division.
