

Site Inspection report of the Divisional Forest Officer, Narsipatnam for diversion of 3.09 ha. forest land for formation and BT to the road including construction of culverts from Vadamamidi to China Agraharam of G.K.Veehi Mandal on 24.11.2018.



Inspected the proposed area for diversion of 3.09 ha. forest land for formation and BT to the road including construction of culverts from Vadamamidi to China Agraharam of G.K.Veehi Mandal passing through Pedavalasa R.L. &

Gudem RL of R.V.Nagar Range on 24.11.2018 along with Range staff and officials of the User agency i.e., Panchayat Raj Division, PIU, Paderu. As per the report of the Forest Range Officer, R.V.Nagar the proposed road is passing through Compt.no.1322, 1491, 1492 & 1493 in Pedavalasa R.L. & Gudem RL of Gudem & G.K.Veedhi Beats of R.V.Nagar Range. The density of the forest in the vicinity is about 0.8. There are 23 Non-teak trees existing in the proposed width of the Road.

The proposed road is recommended as it is essential to the people in tribal villages/ hamlets for their connectivity and essential services like medical facilities, education, marketing of agricultural produce etc. In the inspected area the User agency did not carry out any work in violation of the provisions of FC Act, 1980 and other relevant acts. The required forest area is unavoidable for the project and due to this project there is no threat to the local flora, fauna and there is no archeological heritage importance in this locality.
