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**SITE INSPECTION NOTES OF MS. BOGA NIKITHA, I.F.S., FOREST DIVISIONAL OFFICER, MULUG DIVISION, MULUG ON DT: 23.01.2020.**

The Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force) Telangana, Hyderabad vide Rc. No. 15745/2019/FCA-2 Dt: 19.12.2019 and instructed to inspect the proposed diversion of 0.6984 Ha of forest land in Mulug Forest Division Mulug District in favour of Executive Engineer, R&B Mulugu District for Road network for development of Tourism approach Road to Ramappa Temple Lake from km 0/0 to 2/0 in Palampet RF of Mulugu Forest Division in favor of Dist. (R&B) Officer, Mulug Division and submit the proposals with specific recommendations and findings in Part – II of the proposals through the Chief Conservator of Forests, Warangal at the earliest.

Accordingly a specific report was obtained from the Forest Range Officer, Mulug which is proposed for diversion of 0.6984 Ha of forest land on 23.01.2020. Accordingly, I have inspected the proposed area on Dt: 23.01.2020 and found that the report of the Forest Range Officer, Mulug is justified. The area is falling in Ramappa-I R.F (but not falling in Palampet RF) Compt. No. 565 in Palampet Beat of Palampet Section of Mulug Range of Mulug Division. The Road network for development of Tourism approach Road to Ramappa Temple Lake from km 0/0 to 2/0. The length of line in forest is 698.39 Mts and width is 10.00 Mts in Mulug Range making a total of 0.6984 Ha in Mulug Division. No tree felling is involved. The proposed area having less than 0.4 density. The area required by the user agency is as follows.

The area in question is not falling in any National Park, Bio – Sphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve or Elephant corridor. There is no protected, archeological / heritage site / defense establishment or any other important monuments is located in the area.

There are no endangered flora and fauna is found in that area.

The project is recommended subject to implementing the following mitigation measures.

1. Manual digging of trench without any machine involvement wherever tree growth is there.
2. Local Tribe should be involved for creation of employment generation.
3. (1) No solar powered bore well with percolation tank should be developed by user agency for the protection of flora and fauna in the division for an amount of Rs. 7.50 Lakhs.
4. Administrative cost for an amount of Rs. 5.00 Lakhs to be provided by the user agency.
