Site Inspection Note

Sub: -Inspection of Project Site for Retail Outlet of HPCL at Vill. Mau, Gaya District Proposed along SH-69, Tekari-Mau-Kurtha Road under Gaya Forest Range, Gaya Forest Division on 05th September, 2020 by Shri. S. Chandrasekar, IFS., Conservator of Forest, Gaya Forest Circle, Gaya, Bihar:

The instant project site proposed for diversion of forest land (linear Protected Forest) for making entry and exit passage to the proposedBPCL Fuel Pump by the applicant dealer Smt. Mamta Kumari, W/o Sudhir Narayan, Vill. + P.O. Mau, P.S. Tekari, District - Gaya - 824235, located at Vill. Mau, Thana Tekari, Khata no. 849, plot no. 3961, 3963; District – Gaya located along SH-69, Tekari-Mau-Kurtha Road under Gaya Forest Range, Gaya Forest Division was inspected by the undersigned on 05thSeptember, 2020 in the presence of the applicant's spouse Shri. Sudhir Narayan.

The proposed project requires land for entry and exit of vehicles for the proposed HPCL retail outlet, which has to pass through the linear Protected Forest along the SH-69, Tekari-Mau-Kurtha Road, which was notified vide Department of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of Bihar's notification no. S. O. 400 dated 31.12.1996. The said forest land is bereft of any trees or vegetation and already soil filling has been done and the HPCL outlet is functional. This instant proposed project will not disturb any wildlife, rather, there is no sign of presence of wildlife in the project area. The location and nature of this instant project is not going to affect any wildlife in the area. There is no wildlife sanctuary located within 10 KMs from the location of the proposed project site. The proposed site is barest minimum required for the purpose under reference by the applicant. The applicant's spouse who was present during the inspection stated that the HPCL outlet under reference was made operational in the month of July, 2020.
