**SITE INSPECTION REPORT OF THE CHIEF CONSERVATOR OF FORESTS,
WESTERN ARUNACHAL CIRCLE, BANDERDEWA REGARDING DIVERSION
OF FOREST LAND 89.54 HA FOR LAYING OF 132 KV S/C TRANSMISSION
LINE FROM NAHARLAGUN TO SAGALEE UNDER COMPREHENSIVE
SCHEME IN PAPUM PARE DISTRICT, ARUNACHAL PRADESH.**


The project site for construction of 132 KV S/C Transmission line from Naharlagun to Sagalee under Comprehensive Scheme for Strengthening of Transmission and Distribution in Arunachal Pradesh in Papum Pare District, Arunachal Pradesh has been inspected by the undersigned on 20.01.2020 along with DFO, Sagalee Forest Division, other officials of the Forest Department and the representatives of the user agency. The observations are as follows:-

Out of 89.54 ha forest land required for the project, 16.70 ha falls under Banderdewa Forest Division and 72.84 ha of forest land falls under Sagalee Forest Division. The legal status of forest land is USF. The forest type Eco-class and density are as under :-

During the course of inspection no endangered flora/fauna is noticed or reported. There is no archaeological site or monument on record. The proposal does not involve rehabilitation or displacement of people and no significant effect on general ecosystem of the area is involved.

The Transmission line will be constructed from Naharlagun to Sagalee under comprehensive scheme of T & D system in Papum Pare District of Arunachal Pradesh to provide electrification in the villages' and also generate employment opportunity for the youths of nearby areas involving them in construction works and also during implementation of compensatory afforestation scheme. The project is of national importance, and for the all-round development of the backward tribal state of Arunachal Pradesh. **Recommended for approval by the competent authority.**
