SITE INSPECTION REPORT IN RESPECT OF THE LAND DIVERSION PROPOSAL RECEIVED VIDE STATE SERIAL NO. FP/TR/Others/49971/2020 for diversion of 10.52175ha of forest land under Dhalai Forest District for development of Tourist Destination at Narikel Kunja at Dumboor Lake.

The site inspection of the forest land proposed for diversion was done on **16-03-2021** along with officials from Forest Department and representative of the User Agency.

The observations were recorded as follows:-

- 1. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done on dated **16-03-2021**.
- 2. On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the User Agency is a forest measuring **10.52175ha**.
- 3. The requirement of forest land as proposed by the User Agency in Col. 2 of part-I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
- 4. The forest land proposed for the diversion is located within the forest boundary under Wildlife Warden, Gumti Wildlife Sanctuary, Gandacherra Sub-Division.
- 5. During site inspection it is noticed that construction of path way, Toilet block, Ticket counter have already been done.
- 6. There is no significant wildlife present in the area.
- 7. The area does not form part of National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant Corridor etc. The nearest distance of the Gumti Wildlife Sanctuary from the proposed land for diversion is approximate 2.668 km from the boundary of Gumti Wildlife Sanctuary and 2.638 km from the boundary of Eco-sensitive Zone of the Sanctuary.
- 8. No endangered/ unique species of flora and fauna have been reported in the area.
- 9. The area is not protected archaeological /heritage site and there is no defence establishment.
- 10. There are no important religious sites.
