17. Detailed opinion and specific recommendation of the State Forest Department for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal with remarks.

(While giving opinion the advance comments made by concerned Conservator of Forests or Deputy Conservator of Forests should be categorically reviewed and critically commented upon).

The proposal for diversion of 6.55 hectares of deemed private forest, which has been identified as forest land in the JIT-1 report, is meant for limestone mining (4.14 hect) + safety zone for limestone mining (0.75 hect) + approach road to mining site (0.74 hect) + site office (0.92 hect), i.e. total forest area = 6.55 hectares, of M/s Green Valliey Industries Limited at Madan Pyrda, Chiehruphi, East Jaintia Hills District.

According to the inspection note of the Conservator of Forests (T), Khasi & Jaintia Hills Shillong, out of 6.55 hectares forest land proposed to be diverted, an area of 4.92 hectares of forest land has already been broken-up.

The proposal is therefore recommended to be approved for granting forest clearance subject to applicability of penal compensatory afforestation etc. under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
