

FIELD INSPECTION NOTES OF THE FOREST DIVISIONAL OFFICER, GUDURU (W.L.M.)
ON 03.12.2020 IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROPOSED DIVERSION OF 3.2411 Ha.
FOREST LAND FOR FORMATION OF BT ROAD FROM PWD ROAD TO NEELAVANCH

As per the proposal for diversion of forest area received and request made by the District Panchayat Raj Engineer, Mahabubabad I have inspected the site on 03.12.2020 for formation of BT Road from PWD Road to Neelavancha (Km 9/550 to 13/120) of Gudur (M) in Compt.Nos.983, 982, 981 & 980 of Gudur Reserve Forest, Matwada (East) Beat of Matwada Section, Gudur Range which is falling in the Pakhal Wild Life Sanctuary area of Gudur Range along with concerned Forest Range Officer, Gudur. The User Agency has requested for diversion of 3.2411 Ha of Forest land for formation of BT Road from PWD Road to Neelavancha.

The proposed Road is passing through the Wild Life Sanctuary area with an extent of 3.4211 Ha. The User Agency, District Panchayat Raj Engineer, Mahabubabad has got the area demarcated on the ground. The proposed area having the forest of 0.00 density, as there are no trees present. The breakup of the area required by the User Agency is as follows:

I have inspected the site along with the Forest Range Officer, Gudur along with concerned staff and it was observed that the above forest area is Wildlife Sanctuary area and there is no growth on the proposed road for diversion in Gudur Reserve Forest of Gudur Range. It is observed that the road width can be restricted such that there is no tree felling is required where ever there are trees and in areas where there are no standing trees, the road width as requested by the User Agency is recommended.

The wildlife in the surrounding forest areas are Tiger, Leopard, Wild boar, Spotted Deer, Chousinga, Hare, Peacocks, Sambar, etc.,

The User Agency has submitted their undertakings to implement the following conditions:

The proposals for diversion of forest land to an extent of 3.2411 Ha. in Guduru (W.L.M.) Division of Mahabubabad District for formation of BT Road from PWD Road to Neelavancha in the Wildlife Sanctuary area and with 0.12 Mtrs. Width and there are no trees falling in the proposed area and no flora and fauna will be damaged for the project.


Hence, the proposals for formation of BT Road from PWD Road to Neelavancha in Compt. Nos.983, 982, 981 & 980 of Guduru Reserve Forest, Matwada (East) Beat of Matwada Section, Gudur Range **is recommended with the following conditions.**

1. The Legal status of the Wildlife Sanctuary area proposed to be diverted does not change.
2. Conditions imposed by Forest Divisional Officer, Guduru (W.L.M.) shall be followed by the User Agency are as follows:

3. Any other conditions imposed by the Forest Divisional Officer, Guduru (W.L.M.) from time to time shall be followed by the User Agency.
