

SITE INSPECTION REPORT

The proposed site for up-gradation of road work under Assam Mala project from 22.316 KM to 40.776 KM passes through Manas Reserve Forest joining Koilamoila, Amteka and Malivita Forest Village was inspected on 15th Dec, 2021. The proposed project area under diversion is 36.92 Hecter and there are total 705 nos of standing trees along the road side in the proposed diversion area of Manas Reserve Forest that would be require to be fell if the proposed diversion of additional area of Reserve Forest is approved. The User Agency which has submitted the diversion proposal has not violated the provision of Forest Conservation Act, 1980, as they have not started any work on the proposed site.

In the proposed area for diversion there is no any record of Rare/Endangered/Unique species of Flora and Fauna, no record of Animal Corridor also there is no record of Archeological Heritage site/Depence establishment or any other important monuments in the area. However, the proposed area of diversion is within 10 K.M. away from the Manas 1st Addition of National Park.
