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SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF/DFO
(For the Forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by this office from Sales Officer (Retail sales), Amritsar for diversion (under FCA-1980) of 0.0149 ha of forest land for non-forestry purpose. The subject envisages the use of forest land for Setting up a New Petrol Pump on Jalandhar-Batala Amritsar Bye Pass at Batala Km. 1-2 L/side, Tehsil Gurdaspur, Forest Division, District Gurdaspur. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 18/5/15.

2 On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest area measuring 0.0149 ha.
