	Specific recommendations of the DCF for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal with reasons.	:	<p>The Construction of four laning of NH-363 from Mancherial to Chandrapur due to increasing traffic density in the existing road, is proposed in forest area and there is no suitable alternate land to widen the existing road, as the proposed improvements are along the existing road and project traverses through forest having good growth on either side, the following conditions are to be followed.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Construction of underpasses as mentioned in field inspection report at the cost of user agency</li> <li>2) Fencing the area for funnel effect so that wild life passes through underpasses at the cost of user agency</li> <li>3) Transplanting the enumerated trees to the adjacent RF area at the cost of user agency</li> </ol> <p>Hence it is recommended for considering the proposal, if above conditions is agreed by the user agency.</p>
