

**FIELD INSPECTION NOTE OF THE DISTRICT FOREST OFFICER,
KUMRAM BHEEM-ASIFABAD AND FOREST DIVISIONAL OFFICER, ASIFABAD
(FAC) IN ASIFABAD DIVISION**

Today on 04.07.2018 inspected the proposed area for Diversion of **14.1866 Ha** Forest land for Construction of Warora Pool - Warangal (New) 765 KV D/C Transmission Line in favour of Warora Kurnool Transmission Limited(WKTL) in Asifabad and Rebbena Ranges along with concerned staff. As per the field verification the proposed transmission line is passing through various Reserve Forests, the details of which are as follows.


The proposed transmission line is passing through the different Reserve Forests in Rebbena Range, the length is 1670 meters with a width of 67 Meters and the area required for diversion in Rebbena Range is 11.180 Ha and in the Asifabad Range, the proposed transmission line is passing through Tiger Corridor area of Kawal Tiger Reserve (KTR) with the length of 464.80 Mtrs with a width of 67.00 meters and the area is required for diversion is 3.1142 Ha and the total area is required for diversion for Asifabad Range is 3.1142 Ha.

In the proposed diversion area, no unique tree found. No protected archaeological / heritage site / defense establishment or any other important monument is found in the area. The proposed area is not falling in National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere reserve, Tiger reserve, Elephant corridor, etc. But an extent of proposed area of **3.1142 Ha** falling in Tiger Corridor Linking Kawal Tiger Reserve, Tadoba and Indravati Tiger Reserves.

The proposed area is having with 0.0 to 0.2 Density.



The area proposed for diversion is barest minimum and unavoidable without alternatives for the project. No violation against the Forest Conservation Act, 1980 has been carried out by the User Agency, hence recommended.
