

Site Inspection Report of Divisional Forest Officer, Ananthapuramu in Sy. No. 01/P of Yellutla village of Putlur mandal in Compt. No. 558 of Yellutla R.F. of Yellutla Beat of Tadimarri Section, Ananthapuramu Range on 22.04.2018 in connection with the Diversion of 1.95 Ha., of Forest land for Mining Lease for extraction of Byrates in favour of Smt. J.C. Vijaya, Tadipatri.



Inspected the Mining lease area of 1.95 Ha., applied by Smt. J.C. Vijaya, Tadipatri for mining lease in Sy. No. 01/P of Yellutla village of Putlur mandal in Compt. No. 558 of Yellutla R.F. of Yellutla Beat of Tadimarri Section, Ananthapuramu Range along with the Forest Range Officer, Ananthapuramu on 22.04.2018. Entire area of 1.95 Ha., has been surveyed and demarcated by the Forest Range Officer, Ananthapuramu.

The Species of *Hardwickia binata* (Narepi), Adavi Jana, Chigara, Sundra, Nemali adugu are exists in the proposed mining lease area.

The density of the vegetation is less than 0.10.

The wildlife consists of evidences of Wild Boar, Peacocks, Rabbits etc., The said area is prone to soil erosion.



The proposed area is not a part of National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Bio-Sphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve or Elephant Corridor etc. No rare / Endangered / unique species of flora and fauna are found in the area.

The proposed diversion of area will not cause any adverse impact on the natural eco-system of the area and vegetation including wildlife. There is no much vegetation in the proposed area for diversion.

No protected archaeological heritage site/ defense establishment or any other important monument is located in the area. The forest area of 1.95 Ha proposed for mining lease in Yellutla RF as required by the user agency is unavoidable and barest minimum for the project. No work was carried out in violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
