3) The Chief Manager (Construction), GAIL (India), Ltd., CBD Belapur, Navi Mumbai has submitted proposal for diversion of 3.9443 ha. Forest land under section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for Uran-Usar Propane laying 12" dia liquid propane along with OFC in Uran, Panvel, Pen & Alibag Taluka, Raigad District in the State of Maharashtra. This project requires 3.9334 ha. Mangrove, Protected Forest, Reserved Forest, Restored Private Forest, Finally Acquired Forest, Private Forest (Pending for enquiry) land, therefore the project authority is seeking Government of India permission under Forest (Conservation) Act,

1980. There is no alternate alignment is available and the required forest land is barest minimum for proposed propane pipeline laying 12" dia Liquid Propane Pipeline along with OFC. Proposed alignment of road is site specific and there is no other suitable alternate. (Part-I, P/76)

- 4.7 Proposed project is not likely to affect any monumental site of cultural, historical, religious, archeological or recreational importance. (Part-I, P/63)
- 4.8 There is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. (Part-I, P/51)

- 4.12 The proposed alignment is best suitable from forestry point of view (Part-I, P/99)

- 5.3 The user Agency shall submit non forest land as Compensatory Afforestation before Stage-I approval.(file P/78)
- 5.4 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking regarding the compliance under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 has been applied and is under process and shall be submitted before final approval as per Government of India vide letter No.11-43/2013-FC, dt. 3/12/2018. (Part-I, P/94A)
- 6.0 The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Alibag Forest Division, Alibag and Chief Conservator of Forests (T), Thane have recommended the proposal for diversion of 3.9443 ha. of Forest land. (Part-I, P/21 to 24)
- 2.00 In view of this, the proposal is recommended for approval under the section -2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to the following conditions: –
- 2.1 The legal status of the forest land required will remain unchanged.
- 2.2 Forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over to the User Agency.

#### 2.3 Compensatory Afforestaton:-

- a) Compensatory afforstation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 8.00 degraded forest land in Survey No.45,346 at Village Ambivali & Nere, Tal. Panvel, Dist. Raigad at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.
- b) The User Agency shall submit non forest land as Compensatory Afforestation before Stage-I approval.

2.4 The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.

#### 2.5 NPV:-

- a) The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for the 3.9443 ha. forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30/10/2002, 01/08/2003, 28/03/2008, 24/04/2008 and 09/05/2008 in IA No.566 in WP (C) No.202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No.5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II), dated 18/09/2003 as well as letter No.5-2/2006-FC, dated 03/10/2006 and 5-3/2007-FC, dated 05/02/2009 in this regard.
- b) Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
- 2.6 User Agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
- 2.7 All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (<a href="http://parivesh.nic.in/">http://parivesh.nic.in/</a>)
- 2.8 The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.
- 2.9 The pipeline shall be laid down 1.5 meter below the ground and after lying down of pipe line the ground will be leveled.
- 2.10 The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
- 2.11 No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- 2.12 Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.

- 2.13 The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- 2.14 No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- 2.15 The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
- 2.16 The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Government of India.
- 2.17 Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guidelines F.No.11-42/2017-FC, dated 29/01/2018.
- 2.18 Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.

- 3.0 Keeping in view facts mentioned in above para this proposal for diversion of 3.9443 ha. - 4.11 Proposed Compensatory Afforestation over 8.00 degraded forest land in Survey No.45,346 at Village Ambivali & Nere, Tal. Panvel, Dist. Raigad and it is contiguous, suitable for afforestation and management purpose and it is free from encroachment and an encumbrances. (Part-I, P/52)
- 4.12 The proposed alignment is best suitable from forestry point of view (Part-I, P/99)

#### 5.0 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking that:-

5.1 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking to defray the cost of Net Present Value. (Part-I, P/117)

- 5.2 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking to defray the cost of Compensatory Afforestation. (Part-I, P/115).
- 5.3 The user Agency shall submit non forest land as Compensatory Afforestation before Stage-I approval.(file P/78)
- 5.4 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking regarding the compliance under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 has been applied and is under process and shall be submitted before final approval as per Government of India vide letter No.11-43/2013-FC, dt. 3/12/2018. (Part-I, P/94A)
- 6.0 The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Alibag Forest Division, Alibag and Chief Conservator of Forests (T), Thane have recommended the proposal for diversion of 3.9443 ha. of Forest land. (Part-I, P/21 to 24)
- 2.00 In view of this, the proposal is recommended for approval under the section -2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to the following conditions: –
- 2.1 The legal status of the forest land required will remain unchanged.
- 2.2 Forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over to the User Agency.

#### 2.3 Compensatory Afforestaton:-

- a) Compensatory afforstation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 8.00 degraded forest land in Survey No.45,346 at Village Ambivali & Nere, Tal. Panvel, Dist. Raigad at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.
- b) The User Agency shall submit non forest land as Compensatory Afforestation before Stage-I approval.
- 2.4 The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.

#### 2.5 NPV:-

a) The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for the 3.9443 ha. forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per the

- orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30/10/2002, 01/08/2003, 28/03/2008, 24/04/2008 and 09/05/2008 in IA No.566 in WP (C) No.202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No.5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II), dated 18/09/2003 as well as letter No.5-2/2006-FC, dated 03/10/2006 and 5-3/2007-FC, dated 05/02/2009 in this regard.
- b) Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
- 2.6 User Agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
- 2.7 All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (<a href="http://parivesh.nic.in/">http://parivesh.nic.in/</a>)
- 2.8 The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.
- 2.9 The pipeline shall be laid down 1.5 meter below the ground and after lying down of pipe line the ground will be leveled.
- 2.10 The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
- 2.11 No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- 2.12 Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- 2.13 The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- 2.14 No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- 2.15 The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
- 2.16 The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Government of India.

- 2.17 Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guidelines F.No.11-42/2017-FC, dated 29/01/2018.
- 2.18 Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
- 2.19 The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/)
- 3.0 Keeping in view facts mentioned in above para this proposal for diversion of 3.9443 ha. Forest land under section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for Uran-Usar Propane laying 12" dia liquid propane along with OFC in Uran, Panvel, Pen & Alibag Taluka, Raigad District in the State of Maharashtra is recommended for approval under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
