13.	Specific recommendations of the DCF for acceptance or other wise of the proposal with reasons.		<p>The total length of road including part of bridge is 688 mts i.e. (635 m Road length + 53 mts bridge length) in Chennur Division which is passing through the Compt. Nos. 310 and falling in Chennur RF of Chennur Range. The area of the proposed diversion has been calculated and it comes to be 2.752 Ha (688 Mtrs x 40 Mtrs width / 10000 = 2.752 Ha.). Out of 2.752 Ha. of total diversion, the road covers an area of (635 Mts x 40 Mtrs width / 10000 = 2.540 Ha.) and the bridge covers an area of (53 mts x 40 mts width / 10000 = 0.212 Ha.). The structure of the bridge is 53 mtrs x 16 mtrs= 0.0848 Ha. But the User agency has applied for 40 meters width at Joduvagu, so that, the balance area (0.212 Ha. – 0.0848 Ha. = 0.1272 Ha.) shall be utilized by them in future for further use.</p> <p>In view of the improvement of transport facility for public the proposal is recommended with a condition that mitigation measures shall be taken up by the user agency for wildlife habitat management as this areas has movement of prominent wildlife.</p>
